And without research, a further 27, 000 more lives will be lost to breast cancer by 2030. In the 27 years since NBCF's inception, the five-year survival rate for breast cancer has increased from 76% to 91%. Ultimately, NBCF is working towards a goal of zero deaths from breast cancer by 2030.
